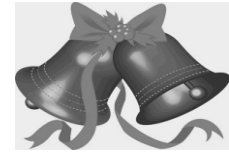

.....Editorial**The peace of the Prince of Peace**

In a world full of strife and turmoil, how much we long for peace. We read the newspapers and find that there is hardly any peace anywhere. Likewise, many homes, including the christian homes, are no exception. This is because we look or sought for peace in all the wrong places. We may be quite prosperous, have everything going well for ourselves, but may lack that deep inner peace, the peace of God. The Bible in Philippians 4:7 says, 'And the peace of God which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Jesus Christ'. Only when Christ reigns in our hearts, will we have such peace.

Horatio G. Spafford (1828-1888), a Presbyterian layman, was a successful businessman. He had invested heavily in real estate on the shore of the Lake Michigan, but his holdings were wiped out by the Chicago fire of 1871. Desiring a rest for his life, he planned a European trip with his wife and four daughters. Due to unexpected business developments, he had to stay back and send his wife and daughters as scheduled on the ship S.S. Ville du Havre, to join them later. The ship met with disaster and several days later, Spafford received a telegram from his wife 'saved alone'. Shortly afterward, he left by ship to join his bereaved wife. It is thought that on the sea near the area where his four daughters drowned, Spafford penned this text, that was to become the famous hymn, "when peace, like a river attendeth my way, when sorrows like sea billows roll, whatever my lot, Thou has taught me to say, It is well, it is well with my soul...". Only those who are truly at peace with God can be at peace in all circumstances in their lives. Another song says, 'With Christ in the vessel we could smile at the storm..'

May this Christmas bring you and your dear ones joy and the peace of the Prince of Peace. May it be a time when you experience afresh His love and blessings.

'For the man who hated Christmas'

A Christmas story

It's just a small, white envelope stuck among the branches of our Christmas tree. No name, no identification, no inscription. It has peeked through the branches of our tree for the past ten years.

It all began because my husband Mike hated Christmas. Oh, not the true meaning of Christmas, but the commercial aspects of it overspending and the frantic running around at the last minute to get a tie for Uncle Harry and the dusting powder for Grandma the gifts given in desperation because you couldn't think of anything else.

Knowing he felt this way, I decided one year to bypass the usual shirts, sweaters, ties and so forth. I reached for something special just for Mike. The inspiration came in an unusual way.

Our son Kevin, who was 12 that year, was on the wrestling team at the school he attended. Shortly before Christmas, there was a non-league match against a team sponsored by an inner-city church. These youngsters, dressed in sneakers so ragged that shoestrings seemed to be the only thing holding them together, presented a sharp contrast to our boys in their spiffy blue and gold uniforms and sparkling new wrestling shoes.

As the match began, I was alarmed to see that the other team was wrestling without headgear, a kind of light helmet designed to protect a wrestler's ears. It was a luxury the ragtag team obviously could not afford.

Well, we ended up walloping them. We took every weight class. Mike, seated beside me, shook his head sadly, "I wish just one of them could have won," he said. "They have a lot of potential, but losing like this could take the heart right out of them." Mike loved kids all kids. He so enjoyed coaching little league football, baseball and lacrosse. That's when the idea for his present came.

That afternoon, I went to a local sporting goods store and bought an assortment of wrestling headgear and shoes, and sent them anonymously to the inner-city church. On Christmas Eve, I placed a small, white envelope on the tree, the note inside telling Mike what I had done, and that this was his gift from me.

Mike's smile was the brightest thing about Christmas that year. And that same bright smile lit up succeeding years. For each Christmas, I followed the tradition one year sending a group of mentally handicapped youngsters to a hockey game, another year a check to a pair of elderly brothers whose home had burned to the ground the week before Christmas, and on and on.

The white envelope became the highlight of our Christmas. It was always the last thing opened on Christmas morning, and our children ignoring their new toys would stand with wide-eyed anticipation as their.....

But Christmas Eve found me placing an envelope on the tree. And the next morning, I found it was magically joined by three more. Unbeknownst to the others, each of our three children had for the first time placed a white envelope on the tree for their dad. The tradition has grown and someday will expand even further with our grandchildren standing to take down that special envelope.

Mike's spirit, like the Christmas spirit will always be with us.
