Child Disciplining

“A fool turns away from the strong teaching of his father...” (Proverbs 15:5)

To give a child wise and fair discipline, every parent needs to understand that there are three steps in discipline.

- 1. Instruction:** A parent needs to tell the child what he is to do. The child needs instruction.
- 2. Warning:** If the child does not obey, the parent must talk to him about his disobedience. Now the child needs a warning (One warning is enough).
- 3. Correction:** If the child still does not obey, correction is needed. This is the right place for correction, after instruction and warning.

Correction that has a strong discipline should only happen when the child openly and defiantly say “NO” to his parents' wishes. A child makes mistakes and is careless at times. He spills milk. He loses things. Parents need patience and understanding at such times. Once in a while a gentle kind of discipline can be used for careless mistakes. The purpose of this discipline is to train the child to be more thoughtful and careful.

Instruction

Instruction is teaching a child how to live, how to do things and how to obey. A good parent teaches his child how to live right, to do things well, to get along with others and to obey.

Warning

In the Bible God warned people before He corrected them. Warning a child keeps parents from being unfair and misunderstanding. It is necessary to warn before correction for the following reasons:

- A parent might correct his child before he knows all that happened.
- The child might not have been the cause of the troubles at all.
- If one gives an answer before he hears, it makes him foolish and ashamed.” (Prov. 18:13)(This verse gives warning not to take action until all the facts are known.)
- The child may not have understood what his parent wanted him to do.
- A parent may have given an instruction that is too difficult or even impossible to obey.

After warning has been given, the parent should be ready to follow with correction. The child will catch on quickly if his parents don't mean what they say about following a warning with correction.

It is confusing to a child when his parents give a warning and do not follow up. When actions agree with words, then the child understands very quickly what he must do. Then he feels cared for and loved.

Correction

The purpose of correcting a child is to shape or control his will. Correction should strengthen the spirit to make a happier child. Correction takes places when a child needs to change his behavior.

Correction without anger: A parent must be sure that the correction and discipline are not done in anger. The child needs to feel that his parent still loves him and is concerned for him as a person. Sadness, rather than anger, should be shown to the child. An angry parent will make an angry child. “... do not be too hard on your children so they will become angry...? (Eph.6:4). A parent should remember that anger only strengthens the will and hurts the spirit. If the parent is sad because of the offence, the child will most likely be sad too.

Correction without embarrassment: The parent needs to get the child alone. If the child is corrected in front of others, he/ she will be embarrassed. He will think more about the other people than about what he did wrong.

Teaching responsibility for actions: The parent should help the child understand that he is responsible for what he did wrong. The parent shows the child from the Bible what he did wrong.

New Year: Destroy Your Enemies

The New Year is a time to reflect upon the year bygone, upon successes and achievements and mistakes. It also gives us a chance to set new goals and to renew our resolve to strive for individual as well as collective well-being. The dawn of the New Year also ushers in new hopes and expectations for us. Well, as we enter a New Year, let us resolve to do one thing that God wants us to do-that is *destroy our enemies*.

What does it mean to destroy our enemies? We live in a time when wars are being fought all over this globe, where men and women, and even children are being destroyed. Enemy fights with enemy, and both are destroyed- yet, the best way to destroy our enemy is not to destruct him, not to mutilate him or to take his life but to make him our friend. In fact, that's what President Lincoln once said when asked about his attitude toward his enemies. One of his associates asked him at one time, "Why do you try to make friends of them? You should try to destroy them". It was then that Lincoln gently replied, "Am I not destroying my enemies when I make them my friends?" And, you know, that's exactly

what God said. The God of the universe, who made all people, said "Love your enemies." Henry Ward Becher once said, "The supreme art of life, above all other arts, is the art of living justly and charitably."

Now, to say that is one thing, but to do it is sometimes a difficult matter. It is impossible to love the conduct of a man who curses you or a man who injures you. But, though we may hate his conduct, though we may suffer keenly when we are affected by it, God insists that we destroy our enemy by making him our friend. That is, hate his conduct, but love the person. We can pity him; we can speak kindly of him and to him; we can return good for evil; we can help him in times of trials; we can seek to do him good and to promote his well being even though we hate his conduct. An Italian Proverb says, "Revenge is a morsel for God." In other words, if someone does us wrong, it does not cancel that evil if we do him wrong in return. It is true- two wrongs never make a right.

An interesting story has been written about a French king Louie, a man who had many enemies. When he came to

the throne, he had a list of his enemies drawn up, and he marked a large black Cross by each of their names. When that became known, the enemies of the king fled, because they thought it was a sign that he intended to punish them. The king, hearing of their alarm, called them, and gave them assurance of his goodwill, saying that he had placed a cross beside their names to remind him of the Cross that brings pardon to everyone. That's the Cross of Jesus. The natural feeling is to do to others as they have done to us, but the Bible says, "Do to others as you would have them do to you." A Chinese sage once said, I meet good with good, that good may be maintained; I meet evil with good, that good may be created." Richmond Franklin once wrote, "Doing an injury puts you below your enemies; revenging one makes you but even with him; forgiving one sets you above him."

So, as we enter a New Year ... and as the sun rises over the New Year, let us destroy our enemies by making them our friends. Let us forgive those who have done us wrong. Let us renew our thoughts and resolve to live peacefully with everyone. I wish you a bright, healthy, peaceful and happy New Year! ■
